Earlier this year, it launched the Revive & Thrive returnship program, designed to help women re-enter the workforce after cancer treatment.

A Mobile Clinic with the Community at Heart


Wellness on Wheels (WoW) is a community-driven mobile clinic providing healthcare services to reach as many beneficiaries as possible.

Hamdan Bin Rashid Cancer Hospital

Redefining Cancer Care for Patients

The Hamdan Bin Rashid Cancer Hospital will be Dubai's first comprehensive cancer center, honoring the legacy of late Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum and his global philanthropic contributions. Designed with environmentally sustainable principles, the hospital will provide a comprehensive range of services in one location, with research and trial at the heart of the hospital's services.

Located in Dubai Healthcare City Phase 2, the **59,000m²** facility is designed with patient wellbeing at its core. The hospital will also include **19** serene gardens for patients, their families, and the wider hospital community.

The Hamdan Bin Rashid Cancer Hospital will serve as a center of excellence for cancer treatment and research in the region, made possible by the generous donations received through Al Jalila Foundation.

The Hamdan Bin Rashid Cancer Hospital was awarded Gold in the **World Architecture News Future Projects Award 2025 – Healthcare category** for its architectural innovation and patient-centered design.
